

## Small School Athletic Federation (SSAF)

### Technical Guidelines

### *Open Golf*

Revised May 27/09

#### **General Rules**

- (1) Generally accepted golf rules are in effect at all times. The following rules are specific to SSAF only.
- (2) Play commences at the start of the horn.
- (3) Each Player must have an individual score.
- (4) Players must carry their own clubs. The clubs that each player uses may be personal or rental clubs.
- (5) There is a double par maximum on each hole.
- (6) One penalty stroke will be given to a player who is out of bounds (in the bush, water, or lost ball). There will not be an additional stroke for a lost ball.
- (7) A maximum time of three minutes will be allowed to search for your ball. If the ball is not found a new ball must be played and a penalty stroke assessed.
- (8) Students must keep track of their own score. Supervisors will keep score on the score card.
- (9) Anyone found cheating will receive a 20-stroke penalty above the highest, or worst score. This score will be one of the 3 scores used to average out the team score.
- (10) Maintain pace with all the other groups. Do not go into the snack bar if there is no group in front of you.
- (11) Supervisors add scores and hand in scorecard at scoring table.
- (12) Coaches complete team score sheet and hand into scoring table.
- (13) Anyone found vandalizing the course or property will be disqualified from the tournament.

#### **Additional Competition**

Longest drive for U20 Boys and Girls, and Male and Female Supervisors.

Closest to the hole for U20 Boys and Girls, and Male and Female Supervisors.

#### **Team Responsibilities**

- (1) All teams must complete the league eligibility sheet and fax it to the league convenor at least 48 hours prior to the tournament.
- (2) Supervisors add scores and hand in scorecard at scoring table.
- (3) Coaches complete team score sheet and hand into scoring table.
